

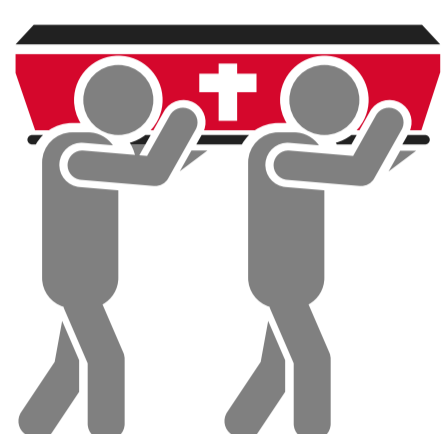
U.S. BURN INJURY STATISTICS



IN 2013, THERE WERE **3,220 DEATHS** FROM A FIRE OR BURN IN THE UNITED STATES

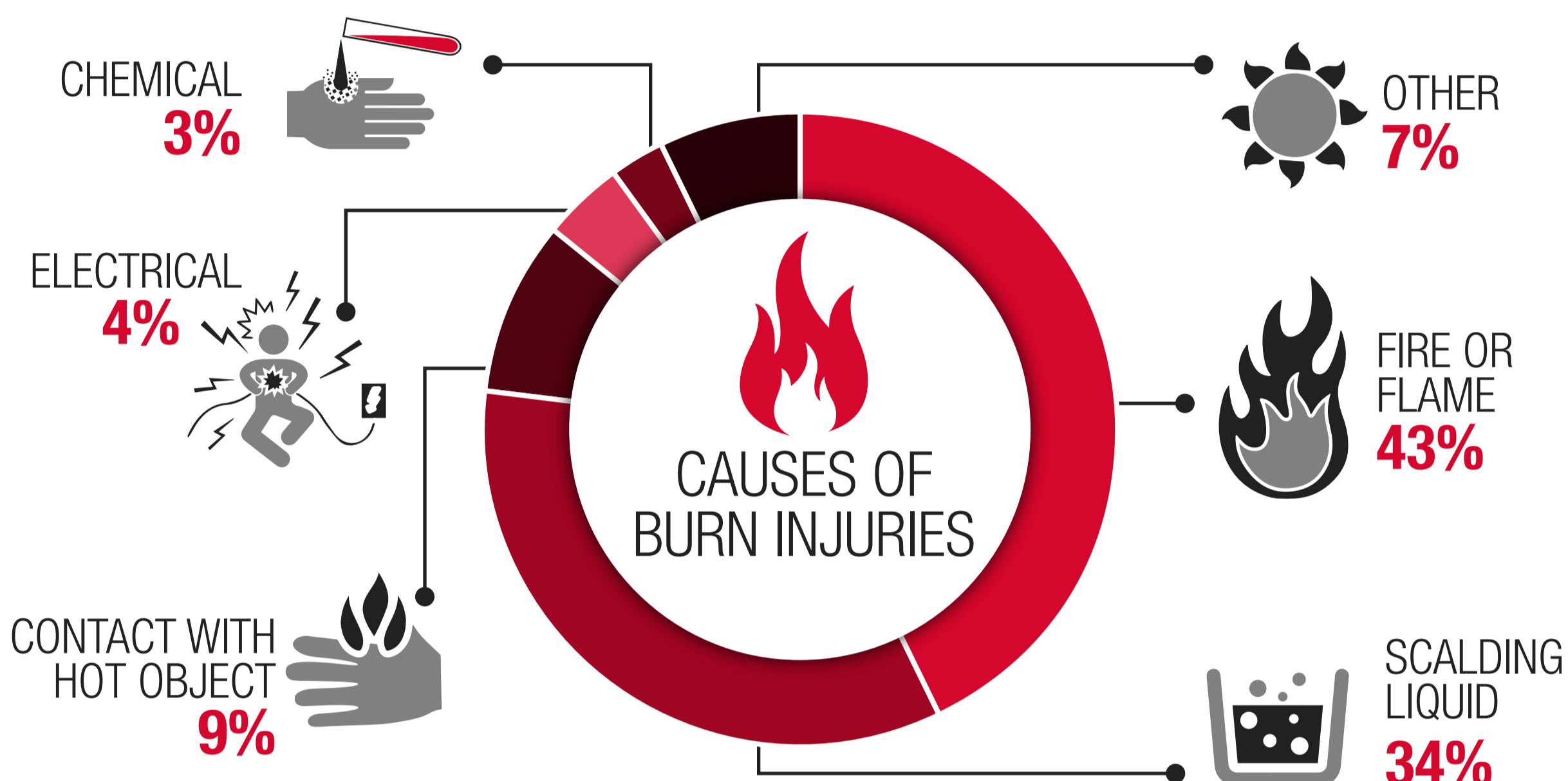


APPROXIMATELY **436,000** PEOPLE REQUIRED MEDICAL TREATMENT FOR BURNS



IN 2013, **334 CHILDREN** (AGES 19 AND UNDER) DIED FROM **FIRES OR BURNS**

126,035 CHILDREN (AGES 19 AND UNDER) WERE SEEN IN EMERGENCY ROOMS FOR FIRE AND BURN INJURIES



WHERE BURN INJURIES OCCUR



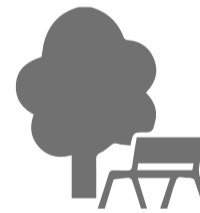
73% AT HOME
